They decided to make over their mugs with a dual face-lift operation on their A&E reality show "Family Jewels." It was Simmons' idea, but Tweed said she wanted to keep up with her man. "I didn't want him to look younger than me!" she said.

So say goodbye to tandem bicycling and side-by-side massages and hello to his-and-hers plastic surgery.

We asked Chicago-area plastic surgeon Dr. Greg Wiener of Resurrection Hospital if there are some famous couples who could use some work. Here are his suggestions for some of Hollywood's finest.

Paul Newman and Joanne Woodward

"Paul and Joanne are true Hollywood royalty," Wiener says. "They were the Nick-and-Jessica of the '60s and they have both aged like a fine wine. Still, if they were looking to have couples plastic surgery, I would suggest a joint eye-lift or perhaps chemical peels. Healthy skin is the secret to looking young, so I would also suggest Retinol or vitamin C creams."

Harrison Ford and Calista Flockhart

"This May-December romance has been going strong for years, but if Harrison wants to keep up with his younger

woman, he might consider a face-lift or neck-lift," Wiener says. "If he doesn't want to go under the knife, he could always try Botox or laser resurfacing. Calista still looks as young as she did in her 'Ally McBeal' days, but she might think about Restylane injections or fat injections in her rear end. Of course, these two stars look gorgeous already ... but there's always room for improvement in Hollywood!"

Warren Beatty and Annette Benning

"Warren and Annette are a Hollywood treasure," Wiener says. "They are both as talented and attractive as they come. However, if they wanted to spice things up a little, I would suggest a midface-lift and some eyelid work for Warren. And Annette could try Botox to eliminate crow's feet. Of course, if they came to me asking for any serious work, I would tell them they certainly don't need it."

Rita Wilson and Tom Hanks

"Wow. This dynamite duo has been together since 1988—and they still stop traffic on the red carpet," Wiener says. "Rita looks gorgeous, so I would suggest something more low-key for her, like microdermabrasion. If Tom wanted to try something new, I would suggest ultrasonic facial liposuction to strengthen his jawline and eyelid surgery to perk up his drooping lids."

Jamie Lee Curtis and Christopher Guest

"This quirky and talented pair seem perfect for each other," Wiener says. "If they

wanted to do some couples plastic surgery, I would suggest an injectable filler like Restylane or Juvederm for Jamie's smile lines, and Christopher could try a neck-lift or midface-lift. Of course, these two lovebirds are always out rocking and rolling—so I would remind them to wear plenty of SPF and sunglasses that block UVA rays."

Kurt Russell and Goldie Hawn

"This couple has staying power," Wiener notes. "They have been together

for over 20 years, and they are still a sexy supercouple. They are always in shape and stylish, so there aren't major changes to make. If Kurt wanted to play up his rugged handsomeness, I would suggest Botox to remove forehead wrinkles. And if Goldie wanted to try something new, she could consider facial laser skin resurfacing to rejuvenate her skin. But she has truly aged wonderfully; Kate Hudson should thank her lucky stars that she has such great genes!"
